Hi There *** It's FESTIVAL TIME ***

Hope you are able to join us for a weekend steeped in music and fun on June 6th and 7th

in conjunction with Indigi Day Out, we are running our 4th. Mini Music Festival. On both days there will be live music on the GARDEN Stage and in the CAFE.

There are workshops; Saturday at 1pm **Chuck Euston** from Stockade will run a guitar cord chemistry workshop. On Sunday at 12 noon **Robin Etter – Cleave** returns to run an Intermediate Whistle workshop, Street performers include **RAGGED MORRIS** Dancers, and **Rosemary's A Capella**.
